### *We welcome you to Hólmur*

Our guesthouse opened the 5.5.05. at 5:05 pm. That was the beginning of the story.

We had been repairing the house for two years, and it costed a lot of work for us, the owners.

The first floor of the house is very old, but the second one was built in 1952. We care a lot about the house, and as many old houses, we believe it has a soul.

We hope you find it as comfortable as ourselves, you sleep well, and enjoy the stay.

Our uniqueness is the stillness in the area, and the spectacular and beautiful nature. The size of our employ gives us the chance to offer you a very personal service, and the nature experience, should fulfill your expectations.

**The guesthouse is open all year, exept Christmas day and New year day.**

### *Owners and occupants.*

The owners names are Magnús Guðjónsson, and Guðrún Guðmundsdóttir, but we go by the names Maggi and Gunna.

We have 3 children, Guðjón Örn, Birna Jódís and Arndís Ósk.

Maggi is born and raised here in Hólmur, but Guðrún is from the north part of the country, to be specific, Húnavatnssýsla.

Maggi's parents live in the yellow house, east of the guesthouse. In the old days, they were the owners of the house you are staying in and the occupants of the estate.

We have a husbandry here in Hólmur. We have a sheeps, and a few horses, goats, many kind of rabbits, guinea-pigs, a icelandic hens and cocks , quails, ducks, geoses and also pig.

2009 we opened a farm zoo here in Holmur.

We have one dog, and his name is Lúkas (Lucas). He's a very good friend, and wouldn't hurt a fly. We have two cats. Nóra is youngest, but one is old and a kind of a snob, her name is Móna Lísá. Sometimes she has kittens.

You will probably see her wandering around, and Lúkas will probably try to get as much attention from you as he can.

Lately we started a windbreak growth, and forest, and we have a so called tree farm.

Both of us are agriculturists, and graduated from a farmer school. Maggi is also a computer-engineer, and Gunna studied the tourist industry in "Hólar" University.



## *The service.*

We offer an accommodation in two houses. In the guesthouse, we have 6 rooms, and also 2 in our own house. The six rooms in the guesthouse are all for 2 persons, without a bathroom. The 2 rooms in our private home, have a double bed, and are without a bathroom. We both offer fully made beds, and beds for sleeping bags. Our guests can have an extra bed, or a mattress if they wish to. In our guesthouse we have a kitchen you can use to cook something for yourselves. One bathroom is on each floor. In our home, we do not offer a kitchen. There you can share the bathroom with our family, and also a lounge.

## *Breakfast*

We offer a breakfast, and it is served in our private home. It's open from 7:30-9:30. If our guests wish to have breakfast at some other time, we try our best to fulfill their needs.

We try to give our guests a miscellaneous and plentiful breakfast. If you have any specific wishes, let us know in time.

## *Dinner*

We also serve dinner if you order in time, and then we most of the time have the day's special. We try to use miscellaneous food from icelandic stock.

## *Notes.*

The owners are most of the time available 24 klst unless there is a note at the reception. You can reach them at their home, or in their phone numbers: 4782063 and 8615959. We are glad to help you and inform you about everything.

For example, the weather, trips, and more. We wish for you to enjoy staying here.

You can use our washing machine and dryer, with charging.



## *Pastime*

You can experience many things while staying here. Hólmur is suitable for travellers who want to stay in the area for a few days.

In a few places you can get very close to a few icefalls. One of them, Fláajökull, is in the property of Hólmur. You can drive or walk from guesthouse to Fláajökull.

You can get easily to the glacier, on a jeep or a snowmobile in Skálafellsjökull. You can also go for a sightseeing trip on the famous "Jökulsárlón", and sail in between the ice floes.

You can visit a very interesting glacier-museum (Ís-land) on Höfn, and there you can also visit other museums and handcraft-shops.

In Höfn there is a 9-hole golfing-court. Two swimming pools are in the area, one in Höfn, and the other one in Öraefi. Both open-air.

From Hólmur it is ideal to go for a day-trip to Öraefasveit. There you can walk around the national park in Skaftafell, or go for a hiking trip on Hvannadalshnjúkur. It's also great to go for a trip to "Ingólfshöfði" with a hay cart on a tractor.

For guests who like taking a walk, you can walk from Hólmur to Fláajökull, which is 8 kilometers away. In front of the glacier, are two marked walking paths. One way to the glacier and other is education path about the the life and struggle of the people with the river (Hólmsá) from the glacier.

Guest can walk along the "Suðurfjörur" (Southcoast), which is 6 kilometers away from Hólmur. There lays a road to the coast, along the "Hólmsá" river. An enjoyable, marked walk is in the forestation in Hornafjörður, "Haukafell".

If the guest like take long day hiking, Heinabergsdalur is great.

It is beautiful valley in nearby. Often people can see reindeer there.

You are welcome to walk around our estate, and admire the nature. There are also a lot of birds around our home.

Our Farm zoo is open all days. From 10-17.

In winter-time there is a free access to the farm zoo for guests that stay overnight. Guests can also feed sheep, calf, rabbits and other animals in their feeding time.



## *Some useful information*

The next town located to Hólmur, is Höfn in Hornafjörður, about 33 kilometers in east.

There you can find most of the service that tourists need.

There we have an Information center, which is open all summer from 08:00-18:00.

In Höfn there is one supermarket, it is by the main street in a large building. In that building

you can also find a hair salon, electronic shop and a clothing store. 2 gas stations are in Höfn, Olís and N1.

You can find 4 restaurants in Höfn. Kaffi Hornið (restaurant, café and bar), Víkin (restaurant and pub), and Ósinn (Hotel and a restaurant), and Humarhöfnin.

You can also grab some fast food at the "Hafnarbúðin". There is a medical center in Höfn, and also a police station.

2 banks are by the main street. "Landsbankinn", and "Sparisjóðurinn". The post office is also by the main street.

There is an open new and good -air swimmingpool in Höfn.

If you like golfing, you can play at a 9-hole course in Höfn.

In Höfn there is a very special show/museum which goes by the name Ice-land, and it's kind of a glacier museum.

There are a few more museums in Höfn, including a sea museum. With the main street is a building there is a craft shop (Handraðinn), with handmade things by people around the area.

## *Environmental affairs*

We try to do everything we can to make our area look nice and clean, though we haven't been in this for a long time.

But the re-building of the guesthouse was our first step. We had to take lots of scrap iron from our estate, because there used to be a carpool here. We also started categorizing many things that used to go straight to the trash bin a few years ago.

We recycle everything that's possible, and give veggies and other food left to our animals.

We use special environmentally safe detergent for washing, and try too keep such things in low volume. Step by step, our aim is to be a part of the Green Globe in a few years, to make our environment better.

If you don't like it, just "shoo" They understands. Please don't take them into the guesthouse.

We would appreciate if you'd help us with the recycling. Put cans and plastic bottles in plastic bags, which you can find in the kitchen.  
Also, we'd like to ask you to take off your shoes in the hall. Please do **not** smoke inside the building.

We love it when guests sign our guestbook, and especially when they draw pictures as well! So we would be very blessed if you'd do that.

## *Recipes*

### **Pancakes a la Gunna og Maggi**

250 gr wheat  
2 teaspoon baking powder  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 spoon sugar  
30 ml oil  
2 eggs  
lemon drops  
and milk.  
prepare with home made jam and whipped cream.

### **Jöklableikja as a starter a la Hólmur**

2 Jöklableikja's (trouts/bleaches)  
2 red onions  
2 spoons butter  
4 spoons sugar  
2 spoons vinegar  
10 tartalets

#### **sauce**

½ can sour cream  
2 spoons mayones  
a lot of chive  
a little bit of mustard.

Boil the trout in í light-salted water. Take the fish skin away and mash.  
Cut the onion and fry it on a pan with butter.  
Put sugar on an empty pan, and add 1 spoon of butter with it, as well as the vinegar.  
Mix, until it looks like caramel. Then add the onion.  
Try not to have the caramel too thick. Put the fish inside the tartalet, and then the caramel-onion. Make the sauce, and prepare with green vegetables and a slice of lemon.

In the summer, many of the animals are outside, but when it gets cold in the autumn we move them into the animal house.

Dear guests provide the animals full care. They do not tolerate excessive noise and calls. Some of them are not much friendly. But some will cares touch and kisses 😊.

Do not put your hands to the rabbits, they can bite or scratch.

Children passing the zoo are on the responsibility of their parents.
